RESPONSIBILITIES:

Medical Directorship

The Medical Director portion equates with approximately 8 hours of administrative time per week within the following context:

- Provides leadership for the planning, organization and quality of medical care provide at all Klinic sites
- Ensures the Klinic's medical practice standards and expectations are in accordance with CPSM Statements, CPSM Guidelines, CPSM by-laws, WRHA Medical Staff By-laws, WRHA policies and procedures and any other legislated requirements
- Provides clinical supervision for professional staff in the Health Services program
- Collaborates closely with the Director of Health Services in ensuring coordination, alignment and effective clinical guidance, consultation and support for medical service delivery
- Recommends, provides and/or facilitates clinical skill development and continuing education activities
- Ensures an on call schedule is maintained which meets the CPSM requirements
- Provides consultation to program directors prior to the implementation of any new or changing health services initiative to assist in ensuring alignment with Klinic policies, procedures and philosophy
- Apprises senior leadership of issues or concerns and advises of sensitive or at risk clinical issues
- Recommends, as part of the hiring process, physicians to be hired
- Supports an interdisciplinary approach to meeting health care needs, facilitating crossprogram collaboration within Klinic services, as appropriate
- Provides effective orientation of physicians new to Klinic
- Represents Klinic and participates in WRHA committees (Site Medical Program meetings)
- Works with senior management to lead program planning, evaluation and quality monitoring
- Responsible for the procedures related to medical practice and delegation of function
- Shared responsibility with interprofessional team with regards to the supervision and evaluation of Physician learners in Health Services
- Establishes and updates clinical protocols
- Works with Klinic Senior Leadership to ensure that services and service delivery are reflective of Klinic's Vision, Mission and values

Primary Care

The Medical Director will provide clinical primary care services approximately 32 hours per week.

- Provides primary health care in a community setting Provides specialized care depending on the needs of the community
- Collaborates with all other service providers at Klinic, including nursing, medical assistants and dietitians
- Communicates effectively with all health team members to ensure client health needs are met
- Participates in after hours and weekend on call services as part of Klinic's Physician Call Schedule

- Participates in training courses and in services as required, offered elsewhere and by Klinic in order to maintain and improve quality of service
- Records daily statistics as required
- Participates in formal self-evaluations by identifying strengths and limitations
- Adheres to all agency policies, procedures, protocols and promotes best practice
- May be required to perform other duties and functions related to this job description but not exceeding above stated skills and capabilities

Physical Demands/Working Conditions

- Work environment consisting of an office building
- Work environment at times may be at individuals' homes and at off-site service facilities
- Moving between different work spaces during shifts
- May be required to move items weighing up to 12 kg
- May encounter aggressive and/or agitated clients and visitors
- May be required to work a variety of shifts including evenings and weekends
