- Provides clinical supervision for professional staff in the Health Services program
- Collaborates closely with the Director of Health Services in ensuring coordination, alignment and effective clinical guidance, consultation and support for medical service delivery
- Recommends, provides and/or facilitates clinical skill development and continuing education activities
- Ensures an on call schedule is maintained which meets the CPSM requirements
- Provides consultation to program directors prior to the implementation of any new or changing health services initiative to assist in ensuring alignment with Klinic policies, procedures and philosophy
- Participates in the development and enhancement of Klinic teams, as consulted by program directors
- Apprises senior leadership of issues or concerns and advises of sensitive or at risk clinical issues
- Identifies and recommends clinical matters that require organizational attention
- Recommends, as part of the hiring process, physicians to be hired
- Supports an interdisciplinary approach to meeting health care needs, facilitating crossprogram collaboration within Klinic services, as appropriate

- Participates in case conferences
- Documents accurate and pertinent client information in a timely manner, including maintenance of medical bands in accordance with Klinic procedures

- Communicates effectively with all health team members to ensure client health needs are met
- Participates in after hours and weekend on call services as part of Klinic's Physician Call Schedule
- Assists in the development of health information resources
- Participates in training courses and in services as required, offered elsewhere and by Klinic in order to maintain and improve quality of service
- Attends staff meetings
- · Records daily statistics as required
- · Participates in formal self-evaluations by identifying strengths and limitations
- Adheres to all agency policies, procedures, protocols and promotes best practice
