RESPONSIBILITIES:

Primary Care

- Provide primary health care in a community setting,
- May provide specialized services in refugee health, latent TB, Hepatitis C and HIV
- Opportunity to provide hospital inpatient care in partnership with physician colleagues, depending on skills and interest.
- Opportunity to participate in antenatal /- intrapartum care depending on skills and interest
- May provide home visits in the geographic community with Community Health Nurse
- Collaborate with Primary Health Care Nurses, Nurse Practitioners, and all Klinik staff

- Participate in case conferences;
- Provide in-service education as requested;
- Chart appropriately, legibly and according to Klinik policies;
- Knowledge of emergency procedures;
- Communicates effectively with all health team members to ensure client health needs are met
- May provide 24 hour on call service as part of the medical call group, including sharing after hour's telephone call responsibilities with other physicians in the group.
