

Masculinizing Procedures/Surgeries (Sub-Tab)

Clients must pay up front for their transportation costs to Montreal. Keep receipts & plane tickets for reimbursement by Manitoba Health.

Procedures	Where is it performed?	Coverage
Hormones (testosterone)	Can be initiated at Trans Health Clinic or by Primary Care Provider	Fully or partially by EIA or insurance benefits
Fertility treatments (ova harvesting & preservation)	Heartland Fertility & Gynecology Clinic/other	Not covered
Chest masculinization	Winnipeg	Covered
Chest reduction	Winnipeg	Case by case
Hysterectomy & Oophrectomy (removal of the internal organs, including the uterus & ovaries)	Winnipeg	Covered Must be on hormones for 1 year
Metoidioplasty (elongation of clitoris, testicular implants) Or Phalloplasty (create penile shaft using skin graft, testicular implants, internal pump in scrotum)	Centre de Chirurgie, Montreal	Covered Must be on hormones for 1 year Living full time in identified gender for 1 year
Laser hair removal (phalloplasty, skin graft)	Winnipeg	Covered
Electrolysis	Manitoba	Not covered---no provider
Chest binding	Manitoba	Not covered
Packing materials	Manitoba	Not covered
Masculinizing voice therapy	Winnipeg, Deer Lodge Centre	Covered
Legal name & gender marker change	Manitoba	Costs involved; (EIA participants, talk to your case worker about coverage)
