Social Workers are part of the inter-professional team at Klinic within Primary care including the Trans Health program. Taking into consideration the Social Determinants of Health model, Social Workers recognize the complexity of interactions between clients and their environment and the impact of this complexity on health and wellbeing of their clients.

- Engage in building and supporting an inter-professional environment
- Liaise with community resources/networks and service organizations
- Supporting Social Work student placements as a Field Instructor
- Facilitates groups
- Provide public education and training activities
- Provides support for learners
- Works as part of a team and promote team functioning
- Charts appropriately according to Klinic procedures
- Participates in training courses and in services offered elsewhere and by Klinic to maintain and improve quality of service
- Attend staff meetings as required
- Participates in program planning, evaluation and quality monitoring including completing daily statistics
